


What did Maria Montessori believe? She believed that children learned better when they're happy and slowly.

There are many forces of nature such as: volcanoes, hurricanes, earthquakes, tsunami and avalanches.


They are powerful and very dangerous.




What is a volcano?


Lesson (1 and 2): Whirlpool.


How should wealthy people contribute to the society? They should offer help to others and give charity.




