VI- Reading Comprehension (6 m)

Your heart is really a muscle. It's located a little to the left of the middle of your chest, and it's about the size of your fist. There are lots of muscles all over your body - in your arms, in your legs, in your back, ...etc. But this muscle is special because of what it does - the heart sends blood around your body. The blood **provides** your body with the oxygen and nutrients **it** needs. It also carries away the waste that your body has to get rid of.

Your heart is like a pump or two pumps in one. The right side of your heart receives blood from the body and pumps it to the lungs. The left side of the heart does the exact opposite: it receives blood from the lungs and pumps it out to the body. By the time you're grown up, your heart will be beating about 70 times a minute.

How does the heart beat? Before each beat, your heart fills with blood. Then it contracts to flow the blood along. When something contracts, it squeezes tighter - try squeezing your hand into a fist. That's like what your heart does so it can flow out the blood. Your heart does this all day and all night, all the time. Every day, an adult heart pumps 2,000 gallons (7,500 liters) of recycled blood by filling and contracting. The heart is one tough worker!







Hurricanes are very bad storms. **They** cause a lot of damage when they pass over a place. Houses are sometimes flattened and the crops farmers grow are destroyed. Sometimes, people die when they get caught inside, or in floods that wash away their homes.

Hurricanes start far out over the Atlantic Ocean when heat makes air begin to move in a circle, and causes rain. Faster and faster the air with heavy rain speeds around like a wheel rotating around its centre.

The centre is calmer and is called the eye of the hurricane. While the hurricane gets faster the whole rotating wheel of wind and rain moves westwards. The largest tornado on record had a funnel a mile wide. There are many interesting stories about strange things that tornadoes have done in the US. Usually **it** destroys an area about 16 miles long and the great damage that it does in one place lasts only about 30 seconds. It's not possible to predict when a tornado will strike although the US Weather Bureau gives a strong warning when conditions are right to cause a tornado. 


