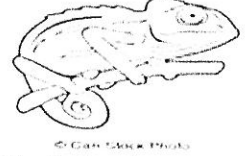

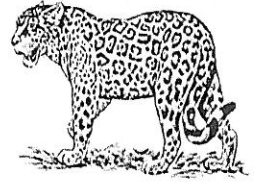
Chameleons Are Reptiles

A mammal is an animal that has hair on its body. Mammals are warm blooded. **Their** bodies stay about the same warm temperature in both hot and cold weather.

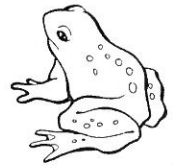
Cheetahs are the world's fastest land animals. They can run as fast as 70 miles per hour. That is faster than most cars driving on a highway .They can run fast for only a short time.
