Giraffes live in savanna areas in Africa. Their height allows them to eat leaves and reaches higher than other animals can reach.

When giraffes walk, they move both legs on one side of their body and then both legs on the other side; this is unique to giraffes. However, they run in a similar style to other mammals, swinging their <u>rear</u> legs and front legs. They can reach 55 km/h at full speed.

Giraffes sleep less than two hours a day. In general, they sleep with their feet tucked under them and their head resting on their hindquarters, but **they** can also sleep for short periods of time standing up.

To help save giraffes' numbers, stop products made with giraffe body parts and encourage others to do the same.
